

POBSC Field Policies – Travel Fields and POBSC Permitted Fields

The following policies will be in place year round for any POBSC permitted field:

- **At all POBSC Travel and School fields (Soccer Park, HS Turf Field, Pasadena, Mattlin, Jamaica, Fern, Parkway, Stratford):**
NO SMOKING OR ALCOHOL ALLOWED.
NO PETS ALLOWED- We love our pets, but they're not allowed on the fields or in the parking lot.
- **Please park inside the gated area or in a designated parking spot.**
- **ONLY POBSC COACHES should submit requests for practice space or game schedule requests.** All requests need to be filled out online at www.pobsc.com. Trainers should not contact field coordinator directly.
- **AEDs – First coach or trainer to the field opens the AED box. Last coach closes the box.**
Note: Soccer park only – AEDS are located in building.
- **RAIN Procedure / Field Closures –** On game days, please review your league policies regarding makeup games due to weather cancellations. **Weekday closures –** I will send an email out to all coaches if fields will be closed.
- **Lightning / Thunder –** If lightning or thunder is in the vicinity, all teams must leave the field for a minimum of 30 minutes since the last sighting. No exceptions. You may return 30 minutes after the last occurrence.
- **NO PRIVATE TRAINING on any POBSC field (Soccer Park, TOB or School) –** No trainer is allowed to privately train on any POBSC soccer field. If your trainer is looking for a usable space, they need to contact travel vice president or field coordinator.
- **Scrimmages –** It is club policy that any scrimmage request granted will only take place on a field designated by the Field Coordinator. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

I ask that you make every effort to have scrimmages at your opponents' fields. There will be limited scrimmage space available at the end of August.
- **Away Game Requests to Home field –** Do not request a switch of an away game to a home game during the season due to weather or poor field conditions. Our home fields are taxed already and we as a club need to protect them. If there is a specific issue (i.e. Town event, rescheduling issues), The Travel VP and Field Coordinator will review your request case by case.
- **Portable Lights –** It is a coaches' responsibility to make sure lights are turned on at the beginning of a session and off at the end of the night. **DO NOT RELY ON TRAINERS OR PARENTS TO COMPLETE THIS TASK.**
Lights at Soccer Park will be positioned by LIJSL Staff – DO NOT MOVE THEM.
- **SHARED SPACE with other Plainview Sport programs / Long Island Rough Riders / Other LIJSL Programs –** There will be a ZERO Tolerance policy with any arguments with other programs or amongst POBSC travel teams.
- **School sports –** No practice shall begin until all school teams are finished with their practices and games. Once school schedules are published, The Field Coordinator will do his/her best to circulate home game conflicts.
